Indian Summer is a national event held every several years, the last time in 2003, covering all aspects of American Indian affairs. This event will expand your understanding of the American Indian culture, provide opportunities from learning to dance, making outfits and crafts, singing, ceremonies, inductions, and much more. You will have an opportunity to gain hands on experience with some of the best trainers and craftsmen in the Scouting movement. There will also be plenty of time to participate in other recreation.

National events don't get any closer than this, and Indian Summer will be held at the Ridgcrest Conference Center in Asheville, NC.

Each lodge is allowed ten (10) participants – so sign up right away. Additional spaces may become available after March 1 if not used by other lodges.

The fee is, depending on a participant's desired accommodations, \$225 or \$325. The \$225 fee will provide air-conditioned, resident housing for 8 participants per room with bathroom facilities. The \$325 fee will provide air-conditioned, standard hotel housing for 2 participants per room with a private bathroom. The fee includes 5 night's housing, 14 meals, program and support materials, and recognition items for the six days. (These amounts already reflect the lodge contribution of \$100.00 per person.)
